Associate membership process

To initiate the membership process

1. The prospective Member must attend four work nights
2. The prospective Member must notify the President, Secretary or Treasurer (members of the Board of Directors) of his or her interest in becoming an Associate Member of the club. The Board of Directors have the right to refuse or accept the membership.

After acceptance as an Associate Member:

1. The Associate Member must pay a \$20.00 one-time fee + \$65.00/year in a one-time payment of \$85.00.
2. The Associate Member should pay his or her membership dues to the club Treasurer.
3. The Associate Member will be given access to the restricted area of the web site
4. It is recommended the Associate Member identify area(s) of interest in model railroading. Areas under the supervision of coordinators on the EMRA layout include scenery, electrical, motive power, operations, rolling stock, signals and track.
5. The Associate Member should find members working in his or her area(s) of interest and volunteer to assist.
6. The Associate Member must attend club functions for a minimum period of six months.
7. The Associate Member must perform "an equitable share of hours" during Fort Edmonton Park's "operating seasons". This will be done with a regular club member.

After meeting the requirements for becoming a Regular Member:

1. A regular member should propose the member for Regular Membership.
2. The Regular club members have the right to an open discussion on the proposal for Regular Membership.
3. All those in attendance at the regular meeting are entitled to one vote. A 75% unopposed majority vote by secret ballot of all members present is required to be granted Regular Membership.
4. If accepted as a Regular Member, Regular Membership dues must be paid in full. Associate Membership dues already paid will be applied as a credit towards Regular Membership dues.

Junior membership process

1. A Junior member is any member under the age of 16 years.
2. Junior members must pay a fee of \$25.00 per year.
3. Junior members must have a parent or legal guardian with them at all times in the club, at club meetings and at club events.
4. Upon reaching the age of 16, the Junior member may apply to become an Associate member.
